

Education Grant Application Instructions

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AS EXPLANTION ALL OF THE RULES AND GUIDELINES THAT MUST BE FOLLOWED FOR YOUR APPLICATION TO RECEIVE CONSIDERATION ARE BELOW.

Note: The Scholarship Matching Grant Program is separate from the Community Matching Funds Program. Further information on these programs is available by emailing the North Dakota Masonic Foundation at grandlodge@nd-masons.com or call 701-235-8321.

The North Dakota Masonic Foundation (NDMF) looks forward to partnering with North Dakota Masonic Lodges in offering the Education Grant program that will provide matching grants for young adults pursuing higher education. The decision to provide matching educational grants shall be made by the NDMF Board of Trustees.

A lodge may apply for Education matching grants <u>up to \$1,000</u> for one or more students during the fiscal year July 1 - <u>June 30</u>. Completed applications can be submitted anytime as they are processed quarterly. If a lodge wishes to spread its contributions between various students throughout the year, it can be done through multiple submissions or through one submission if all details are indicated by the lodge.

Instructions:

- 1. Write information legibly. Make sure all signatures are obtained before submission.
- 2. Lodge may request up to \$1,000 matching funds each fiscal year (July 1 June 30) for this grant.
- 3. Student(s) must be 25 years old or younger
- 4. Both males and females are eligible to receive the scholarship.
- 5. If the lodge choses the recipients, the lodge must have a scholarship application process.
- 5. The lodge must discuss the applications at a special meeting and collectively decide the recipient(s).
 - All decisions must be based off of the student's application for scholarship.
 - An application example can be obtained by reaching out to the Foundation's Office.
- 6. The student(s) must be enrolling into a North Dakota or neighboring state school of Higher Education.
- 7. The student(s) must be North Dakota residents.
- 8. The student(s) do NOT need to have any affiliation or family in a Masonic Organization.

HOW TO APPLY

Fill out the application thoroughly and provide necessary supporting documents. Applications can be submitted either electronically or by mail:
